TESTING WEEK

On April 15th thru the 19th, students in grades 1st through 8th will participate in standardized assessments. Success during these assessments require a collaborative effort of school personnel, parents, and students. To support your child's testing performance, we are asking that parents assist with the following:

- ◆ Make every effort to see that your child is in school to take the assessments on the dates listed. Please do not schedule any appointments during the morning hours of testing week.
- ◆ It's critical that your child report to school on time. **Students MUST be in class by 8:10 AM.**
- ◆ Ensure that your child has a good night's sleep each night prior to the test.
- ◆ Provide a healthy breakfast prior to taking the assessments each morning.
- ◆ Discuss the importance of putting forth his or her best effort each day of the assessment with your child.
- ◆ Stress to your child that all cell phones, smart phones, and other prohibited electronic devices are not allowed during test.
- ◆ The ACT Aspire has strict guidelines and consequences if the integrity of the assessment is comprised.
